FADE IN:

INT. KITCHEN - DAY

JERRY is on his way to drink a glass of water. He opens the cupboards and is met with an unpleasant surprise. All of his dishes are gone.

Cut to JERRY, like a reality television interview style, clearly disgusted with what had happened to him earlier.

JERRY

(With an attitude)

Yeah, I know it was fucking Dylan.
He is always using my dishes
without permission. Like, who does
that? It's so -

Cuts back to JERRY discovering that all of his dishes are dirty, piled up high in the sink. He is visibly pissed off as he storms out of the frame.

Cuts to JERRY in an interview.

JERRY (CONT'D)

Annoying. I'm so done with him.

Cuts to DYLAN in an interview.

DYLAN

Oh Jerry, yeah he's a horrible
roommate. Overly sensitive. (Leans
in closer to the camera and
whispers) I think he has like
mental issues...OCD. Is that like
contagious?

INT. BEDROOM - NIGHT

Cuts to DYLAN talking on the phone, laughing and talking loudly.

DYLAN

Oh my god! Black pink is going on
tour? Of course, I'm down to -

JERRY

(Interrupts) Do you mind?

Pans to JERRY, trying to work. His headphones are out of his ears, indicating that he can hear Dylan's voice through the noise cancelling headphones. He puts them back in.

DYLAN

So sorry! I'll keep it down.

DYLAN continues to talk at the same volume. In fact, it appears to be that he is deliberately talking louder than before.

Cuts to JERRY, he takes his headphones off and sets it down on his table angrily.

Cuts to JERRY in an interview.

JERRY

(While clapping to emphasize his statement). He had the audacity to continue talking even louder.

Cuts to DYLAN in an interview.

DYLAN

Oh please, I wasn't even talking that loud. It was only like 9pm. Can't he go somewhere else to study?

INT. BATHROOM - DAY

Cuts to JERRY doing his business. He reaches for the toilet paper, he notices that there is only a single piece of toilet paper left.

Cuts to a close up of JERRY.

JERRY

What the -

Cuts to JERRY in an interview.

JERRY (CONT'D)

(Long censor to indicate that Jerry is cursing). Isn't it common courtesy to refill the toilet paper? Worst of it all, do you know what happened the other day -

INT. KITCHEN - DAY

Cuts to JERRY trying to dispose his food scraps. The trash is overflowing. JERRY pinches his nose in disgust.

Cuts to DYLAN in an interview.

DYLAN

Oh, the trash (pause) yeah my bad.
I know it was my turn, but I had a
really busy week. Jerry should be
more understanding.

Cuts to JERRY in an interview.

JERRY

Understanding? I literally had to
take out the trash the past few
weeks.

DYLAN

He's overreacting.

JERRY

He's inconsiderate.

DYLAN

Sensitive.

JERRY

Disgusting.

DYLAN

Worst than my -

Cuts to a half split screen to both DYLAN and JERRY in an
interview style.

JERRY AND DYLAN

(Simultaneously but at separate
times) Ex-roommate.

INT. KITCHEN - NIGHT

JERRY is standing in front of the opened refrigerator. It is
eerie and unsettling to the audience as we can hear him
aggressively slurping or eating something.

Cuts to a close up of JERRY'S mouth. The audience does not
know what he is eating, but we can see small stains of red on
his fingers and lips.

INT. BEDROOM - NIGHT

DYLAN wakes up from his sleep due to a strange noise. He
checks his phone to see what time it is. It is very late at
night. He gets up to check outside the window. He sees a
glimpse of a black silhouette passing by.

Cuts to DYLAN in an interview.

DYLAN

Yeah, sometimes I see this strange black silhouette late at night. At first, I thought I was dreaming...

EXT. ALLEYWAY - NIGHT

Opens to a street lamp.

Cuts to JERRY, who is currently jogging at night. He is listening to music with his Air Pods. After he reaches to the end of the street, he takes off his Air Pods. Once he takes off his Air Pods, the music cuts off, and the audience is greeted with static and white noise.

Cuts to a medium shot of JERRY heading to a darkly lit alleyway. He is pulling a mysterious trash bag.

INT. BATHROOM - NIGHT

Fades in to JERRY staring at himself in the mirror. He is visibly looking distressed. However, at the end he visibly smiles eerily.

Cuts to JERRY in an interview.

JERRY

(In a soft voice) To be quite honest, I haven't been able to get much sleep these past nights. Dylan has been getting on my nerves...

INTERVIEWER

(Cuts in) I'm sorry, could you repeat that again. We couldn't capture the audio.

JERRY

(After a long pause) Dylan will soon be an ex-roommate.

INT. BEDROOM - DAY

DYLAN texts JERRY a message along the lines of "Can I have the room for the next few hours? I have an interview."

Cuts to DYLAN in an interview.

DYLAN

I honestly think I am being quite reasonable. I think Jerry is...

DYLAN suddenly looks to the left in shock.

The camera rapidly pans to the direction of what DYLAN is looking at but it is unclear.

Cuts to a jump scare of JERRY'S face.

EXT. STREETS - NIGHT

Cuts to a low angle of JERRY struggling to pull the mysterious trash bag, ultimately dumping it in the large waste disposal bins.

INT. BATHROOM - NIGHT

Cuts to JERRY washing his hands. The water is red.

Cuts to JERRY looking up at his reflection. There are red stains on his mouth and teeth.

INT. KITCHEN - NIGHT

Cuts back to the scene where JERRY is sitting in front of the fridge. Now, it revealed that he is eating a piece of flesh or some strange thing that indicates that it is a piece of DYLAN.

INT. BATHROOM - NIGHT

Cuts back to JERRY staring at his reflection. He checks out his red-stained teeth. He begins brushing his teeth. Quite aggressively...as if he is very particular about it.

INT. BEDROOM - NIGHT

At a desk, JERRY is scribbling something on his notebook. A close up reveals various names crossed out. The last name on the list is DYLAN. JERRY proceeds to draw a 'X' through his name, indicating that he is no longer exists. JERRY sets the red marker down and closes the notebook.
